GET UP TO \$7,500 OFF AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE

Up to \$2,500 - Standard Rebate

Up to \$2,500 off the **purchase or lease of a new battery electric vehicle, plug-in hybrid electric vehicle or zero-emission motorcycle.**

\$5,000 - Charge Ahead Rebate

\$5,000 off the **purchase or lease of a new or used battery electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle** for low- to moderate-income Oregon drivers.

Up to \$7,500 - Standard + Charge Ahead Rebate Combined

Up to \$7,500 off the **purchase or lease of a new battery electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle** for low- to moderate-income Oregon drivers.

WHO QUALIFIES?

HOW TO APPLY

THERE ARE THREE WAYS TO APPLY

1. Ask your dealer how to apply the rebate as "cash on the hood"
2. Apply online at evrebate.oregon.gov

WHAT DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED?

- Rebate Application Form
- Proof of Oregon residency
- Complete purchase/lease agreement
- Proof of vehicle registration
- Household Summary Form (Charge Ahead only)
- Proof of enrollment in a public assistance program (Charge Ahead only)
OR 4506-T for each household resident (Charge Ahead only)
- 501(c)(3) nonprofit determination letter from IRS (For low income service providers)

STACK REBATES AND INCENTIVES

COMBINE OCVRP REBATES WITH OTHER INCENTIVES!

- OCVRP Standard Rebate – Up to \$2,500 off.
- OCVRP Charge Ahead Rebate – \$5,000 off for low- to moderate-income Oregon drivers.
- Combine OCVRP Rebates – Up to \$7,500 for low- to moderate-income Oregon drivers who combine the Standard and Charge Ahead Rebates!
- Federal Tax Credit – Deduct \$2,500 - \$7,500 depending upon tax liability and vehicle manufacturer.
- Utility Rebates – Utilities across Oregon offer rebates for EVs and installing charging stations. Check for local rebates, visit goelectric.oregon.gov/incentives-rebates to learn more.

ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

New vehicles must have a base MSRP under \$50,000.

Used vehicles must have an original base MSRP under \$50,000.

Vehicles must be purchased or leased through a certified vehicle dealer OR an original equipment manufacturer.

No person-to-person sales are allowed.
